

Recruitment, Development, & Retention

FOR TEACHERS, PRINCIPALS, AND OTHER SCHOOL LEADERS

The purpose of Title II, Part A is to provide subgrants to local educational agencies (LEAs) to –

- Increase student achievement consistent with the challenging State academic standards
- Improve the quality and effectiveness of teachers, principals and other school leaders
- Increase the number of teachers, principals, and other school leaders who are effective in improving student academic achievement in schools
- Provide low-income and minority students greater access to effective teachers, principals and other school leaders.

Teachers, principals, and other school leaders are eligible to receive services funded by Title II, Part A for recruitment, professional development, and retention.

Funds cannot be used for students or classroom support.

LEAs receive an allocation based on enrollment and poverty data. Private schools and charter schools are eligible to receive an equitable portion of the host LEA's allocation for Title II, Part A services.
