# Program Office Progress During 2020-21

- Reorganized staff into two main units: Program Support & Monitoring and Compliance
  - Program Support provides contract management, programmatic monitoring and technical assistance to subrecipients
  - Monitoring and Compliance provides fiscal and administrative monitoring and technical assistance to subrecipients
- Reduced reporting under evaluation and expenditures associated with reports
- Developed a new state evaluation strategy in line with changes to federal requirements

- Instituting a 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC Florida Advisory Board Application Process



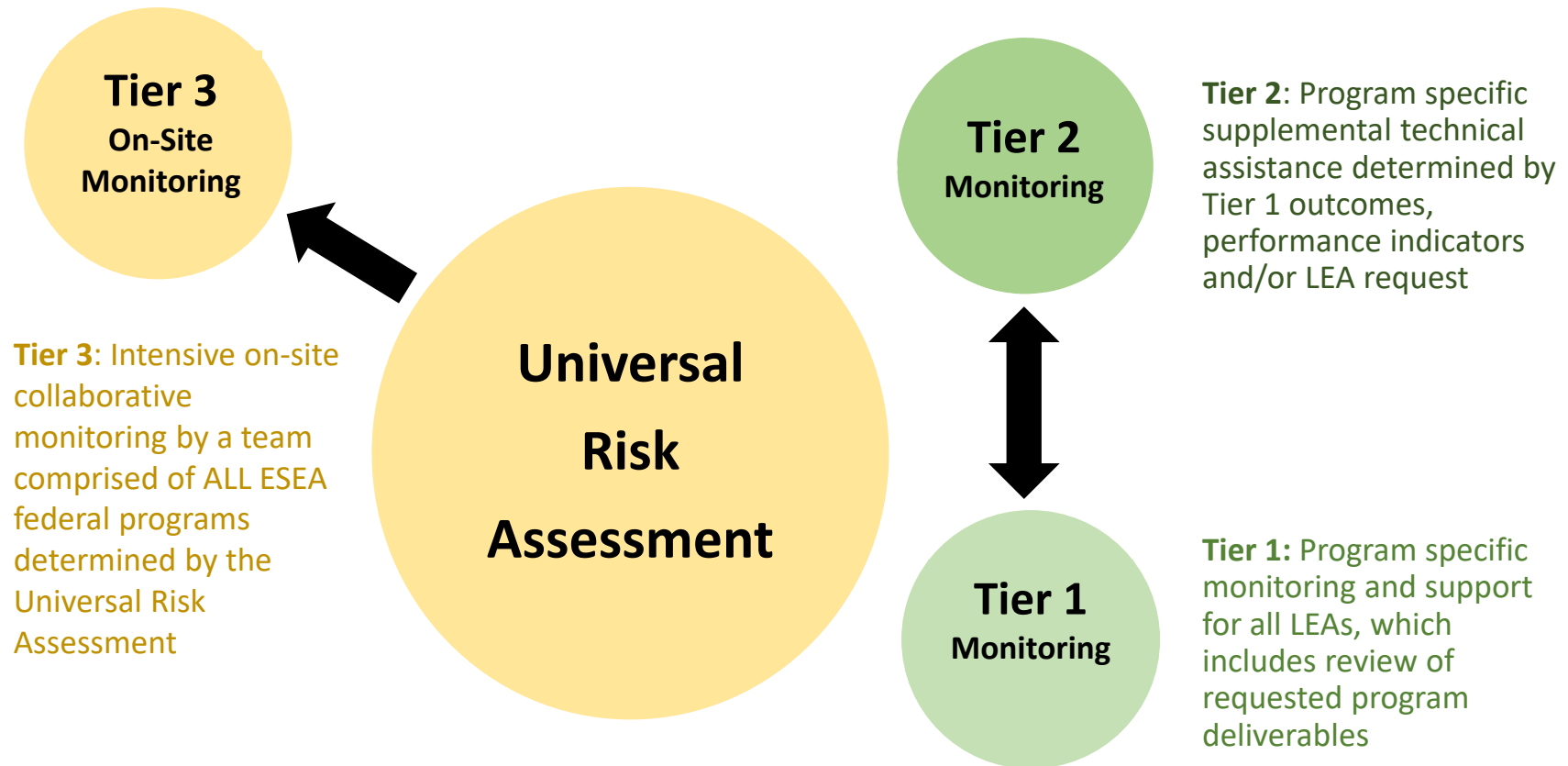

# Tier 1 Support

- Tier 1 Monitoring is universal support for success
- Application review and approval
- Reimbursement review and approval
- Three monthly deliverables for all subrecipients
  - Attendance
  - Contact hours
  - Data updates
- Quarterly document review for all subrecipients
  - Training
  - Document submission

# Tier 2 Support

- Tier 2 support is specific technical assistance for subrecipients based on deliverables submissions.
  - Amendment review and approval
  - Monthly calls to discuss
    - Attendance targets
    - Provision of hours of balanced programming
    - Attendance for students in a range of activities (dosage)
    - Student performance targets
    - Changing enrichment strategies based on performance data
    - Quality of deliverables submission
  - Quality site visits

# Tier 3 Support

- Tier 3 Support is intensive onsite support for subrecipients based on assessment of risk.
  - Risk assessment elements include:
    - School improvement status
    - Experience with 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC
    - Amount of funding
    - Number of awards
    - Timeliness of submissions
    - Attendance targets
    - Unexpended funds
    - Attendance at technical assistance meetings and training
    - Agency type
