- 2016 Master Schedule Analysis system developed to identify and remove barriers preventing students from having access to opportunities for acceleration
- 2018 Accelerated Math course in elementary (3rd, 4th & 5th grade)
- 2019 Time task tracking system created for secondary schools to assist
 Principals in effective Master Schedule Analysis and planning
- 2021 Time task tracking system for elementary schools to use a comprehensive approach to scheduling where teachers, parents, Principals and their supervisors consider the student potential
- **2022** Full implementation of K-12 scheduling system including a systems analysis
- 2023 -
 - Implementation of the Transition to Kindergarten (T2K) Initiative
 - Enhanced parent outreach to inform about benefits of acceleration








