Involvement of Families/Stakeholders

Coral Sunset has held meetings including families and community partners, revising our Parent and Family Engagement Plan. These meetings also reviewed our Title I programs and how funding will be spent for Family engagement. The funds will be used to offer more hands-on parent trainings so families can support their children at home with homework and foundational skills. Materials will be available for parents to check-out, including games, educational materials and videos. Teachers will be available to support parents and assist with curriculum questions.
