Mission Statement

Pines Lakes Elementary School, in partnership with its children, families, and community, guarantees each child a superior education by providing quality instruction and challenging learning experiences in a safe and orderly environment which will foster life-long learning and responsible citizenship.

Involvement of Parents

Flexible Parent Meetings

Pines Lakes Elementary will offer a flexible number of meetings, such as meetings in the morning or evening, and may provide with Title I funds, transportation, childcare, or home visits, as such services related to parental involvement [Section 1118(c)(2)].

Pines Lakes Elementary will schedule meetings at various times during the day and evening to better accommodate parents. To encourage attendance students will receive an incentive if their parent attends a "Title I" event.
