

## PARENT-SCHOOL COMPACT

<u>Leto High School</u> and the parents of students participating in activities, services, and programs funded by Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) agree that this compact outlines how the parents, the entire school staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and, parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the state's high standards. This school-parent-student compact is in effect during the 2015-2016 school year.

## School Responsibilities

Leto High School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the state's student academic achievement standards as follows:

Leto will offer a wide range of courses including but not limited to: Advanced Placement courses Dual Enrollment courses, vocational/career courses, academic support programs (AVID, ELP, credit recovery, SAT/ACT preparation, and online courses)

2. Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's academic achievement. Specifically, those conferences will be held:

Progress Reports will be posted at each mid-nine week period.

- Report Cards sent home every 9 weeks.
- Teachers will keep parent informed about failing grades and attendance problems on a regular basis.
- Teachers will post grades and class assignments on Edsby on a regular basis
- 3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.

Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:

- Twice a Semester, (+Annual Title 1 meeting),
- On request by parent, student or teacher
- 4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:

- Promote positive use of children's extracurricular time
- Stay informed about children's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district, either received by children or by mail, and responding as appropriate,
- Serve, to the extent possible, on policy advisory groups, such as: Title1, School Advisory Committee, the Title III Policy Advisory Committee, the District Wide Policy Advisory Council, the State Committee of Practitioners, Discipline Committee, School Steering Committee or other school advisory or policy groups.
