Yes, the grant will require wrap-around services. As you develop your plans, keep in mind that a plan must, at a minimum, address the following six key areas of assurance selected by the district based upon the school's needs assessment to implement a whole-school transformation model.

The school will:

- 1. Provide wrap-around services that develop family and community partnerships.
- 2. Increase parental involvement and engagement in the child's education.
- 3. Establish clearly defined and measurable high academic and character standards.
- 4. Identify a knowledge-rich curriculum that the school will use to focus on developing a student's background knowledge.
- 5. Provide professional development that focuses on academic rigor, direct instruction, and creating high academic standards and character standards.

The school district will:

6. Identify, recruit, retain, and reward instructional personnel.

This webinar is for schools that intend to apply for Schools of Hope funding for the 2018-19 school year.

Yes, the PPA is required.

A complete application must include all 5 documents as follows:

- TOP-3
- DOE 100A Project Application Form
- Project Performance Accountability Form
- TOP-3 Budget Development Tool
- DOE 101S Budget Narrative Form

6. Just so we have the date penciled in when is the RFP due again?

The application package must be submitted as a hard copy and received by the Office of Grants Management (OGM) by Friday, September 14, 2018, at 5:00 PM Eastern Time. Upon submission, please email BSI@fldoe.org an electronic copy of the complete application and proof of submission, such as a certified mail receipt.

7. Can you review Top 2 and Top 3 again in regular terms not what is on the slide

The TOP-2 must be completed for each school that is required to implement a turnaround plan in the 2018-19 school year and must be unconditionally approved by the State Board of Education (SBE) at the October 25, 2018 meeting in order for a TOP-3 plan to be considered for that school. The TOP-3 must be completed for each school that is applying for Schools of Hope funding. In order for a TOP-3 proposal to be considered for approval at the October 25, 2018 SBE meeting, the TOP-2 must be unconditionally approved by the SBE and The TOP-3 must receive a qualifying score based on the rubric and extended rubric.
