

 Documentation of an analysis conducted to determine the impact of the activities on increased student achievement, teacher effectiveness, teacher recruitment and retention, and prioritizing effective instruction for high needs students.

Examples of Program Evaluation Documentation

Summary of an activity and the impact on student performance, a list of supporting documents

ELL Support Leader/Coach- ELL student data showed the following for school year 2021:

- 720 (77%) of ELL students showed growth in Reading as indicted by iReady end-of-year score growth data.
- Total student growth by grade at BPES showed ELL students grew 17% in Literacy and 21% in Vocabulary as indicted by Imagine Learning
 assessment scores.
- Total student growth by grade at MBES showed ELL students grew 27% in Literacy and 18% in Vocabulary as indicated by Imagine Learning
 assessment scores.
